

TROOP 842 NEW SCOUT EQUIPMENT LIST

The items listed below are the basic items that each Scout will need to start their Boy Scout camping trips. As each Scout becomes older additional items might be required.

Official Scout Uniform (See Uniform Purchasing Guide)
Troop 842 Activity Uniform (Troop 842 T-shirt worn with official BSA shorts or long pants,
BSA green socks and BSA belt)
Boy Scout Handbook

2 Man Tent w/rain fly and ground cloth
Sleeping Bag (with waterproof stuff sack)
Ground/Sleeping Pad
Camp Pillow
Rain Poncho
Mess Kit
Eating Utensils
Metal Drinking Cup
Canteen/Water Bottle or Hydration pack (1Qt. Min.)
Compass
Flash Light
Pocket Knife (locking blade preferred) (Scout must earn their "TOTIN' CHIP" to carry knife)
Day Pack (similar to their school book bags)
Ditty Bag (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, hair brush/comb, etc.)

*** Troop 842 will conduct a parents "Camping Equipment Show" before first campout to assist new scout parents in purchasing the correct equipment.**

The following items are equipment that parents should not purchase until later, when the Scout is older.
