Oak Leaf Training – Camp Wisdom

4/25/2009 to 4/26/2009 Oak Leaf is for scouts who are ready to assume a leadership position in their troop. This overnight training experience places the participant in a working patrol where they will participate in the patrol method, learn the workings of the patrol and troop, and be introduced to some introductory leadership skills. The objective of Oak Leaf is to give the Scout the confidence and skills needed to be a successful leader.

National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT)

Spring Session March 16 - March 21, 2009. NYLT is an intense, 5 1/2 day, outdoor leadership training program for youth troop leaders. The course goal is to prepare young men to become superior leaders in their troop, their district and other organizations they belong to now and in the future. Oak Leaf is not required as a prerequisite for NYLT.
